

Entry requirements

To apply for the FRANZCOG training program you must be qualified in Medicine and Surgery, with a primary degree issued in Australia or Aotearoa New Zealand, or from an approved international institution.

If you're accepted into the FRANZCOG training program, your training cannot commence until

you have:

- completed postgraduate year 2 (PGY2) or above
- secured an accredited training position
- obtained prospective approval of your training position from RANZCOG.

How to Apply

• FRANZCOG Training Selection is highly competitive. Throughout the selection

process, the College bases its assessment of each prospective trainee on consistent selection criteria.

There are currently four pathways to Fellowship: the Generalist Pathway, Academic Pathway, Advanced Obstetric Pathway and Subspeciality Pathway.

Total Training Time

The FRANZCOG training program involves 276 weeks (six years) of hospital-based training and assessment. Training is divided into two components:

- 184 weeks (four years) of Basic Training,
- 92 weeks (two years) of Advanced Training.
