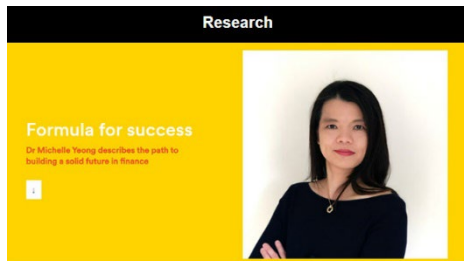
Please include:

Resilience and understanding are the fundamentals of accounting, says experienced finance professional [Dr Michelle Yeong](#).

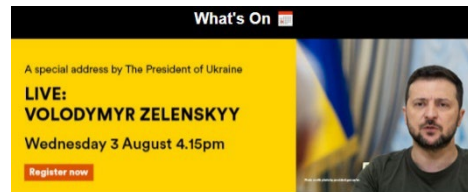

### Learn to be a better MATE

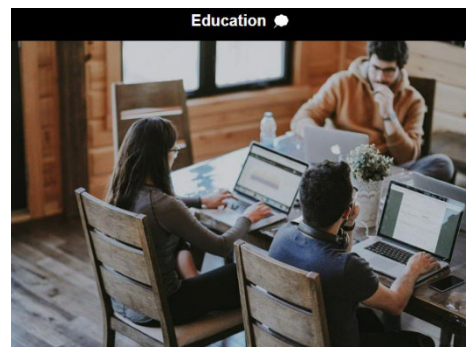
Australia's leading training program for the prevention of violence, discrimination and racism is now being offered to all Flinders University staff and students.
