In particular this may address ways of shaping policy, laws and political behaviours to enhance national security, governance of society and democracy through technological change. It may also address the risks of such technologies.

At Flinders University, the Distinguished Scholar will be affiliated with the College of Business, Government and Law. They will also be encouraged to associate with the Government Discipline and the Jeff Bleich Centre for the U.S. Alliance in Digital Technology, Security and Governance.

### ABOUT THE FULBRIGHT PROGRAM
