## Notes:

- Throughout the MBA, students will only be able to swap one of their core topics for a WIL topic worth 4.5 units (Standard as an individual student engaging with a company OR as a team of students through an Industry Entrepreneurship Program). The BUSN9516 WIL topic (9 units) from the MBA Industry Focused can't be used for an Industry Entrepreneurship Program as it is worth 9 units, equivalent to 250 hours of engagement with industry.
- Each Industry Entrepreneurship Program will be capped for now at 25 students (still dependant on the growth of the total number of Flinders MBA students).
