

Purpose

The Flinders University Summer Research Award has been established to provide an opportunity for students interested in undertaking honours or higher degree research. The award will provide students with an opportunity to be involved in a research project under the supervision of a member of staff.

This award is solely for educational purposes. The recipient is under no obligation to perform any work nor are they required to attend at the University or elsewhere, at any particular time.

There is no intention to create an employment relationship. The timing of the research project will normally take place during the summer vacation period and will be determined by the supporting College.

Benefits

The award benefit may vary depending on the research project and the funding source. The benefit will be advertised in conjunction with the application process.

The award benefit will be paid in a single lump sum payment at the beginning of the award.

Eligibility

Applicants must be a current full-time, undergraduate or postgraduate coursework student of an Australian University.

Additional eligibility criteria may apply depending on project and supporting College requirements. Any additional eligibility criteria will be advertised in conjunction with the application process.

Tenure

The award duration may vary depending on research project length. Specific details will be included in conjunction with specific award opportunities.

Selection

Selection will be based on academic merit.

Additional selection criteria may apply depending on project and supporting Faculty or School requirements.

Any additional selection criteria will be advertised in conjunction with the application process.

Selection will be made within the College offering the Summer Research Award.
