

Background

Flinders Housing has established the University Hall Rural Scholarship for Continuing Students residing in University Hall.

Purpose

The scholarship is available to students continuing to reside in University Hall. Subject to the availability of funds there will be one annual scholarship valued at \$1,000 which will be credited to the recipient's Accommodation Fee account at Flinders Housing.

Benefits

The scholarship is funded by Flinders Housing

Eligibility

Applicants for the scholarship must be permanent residents of rural Australia who:

- (a) normally reside outside the Adelaide metropolitan area and the metropolitan areas of other major Australian cities (as defined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics Local Council areas); and
- (b) have previously lived in University Hall for a period of not less than one semester; and
- (c) will be residing at University Hall for the duration of the academic year in which the award is made; and
- (d) will be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate course of study at Flinders University; and
- (e) are able to demonstrate financial hardship.

Selection

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need and academic merit. Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Academic and Student Services.

Applications

Applications will be made via the Student Information System.
