

Purpose

The object of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance for full-time honours students studying performing arts at Flinders University.

Source of funds

The scholarship has been established as a result of a generous donation from the Adelaide Theatre & More Social Club Inc.

Benefits

Each scholarship will have a value of \$5,000. Payment will be made in two equal instalments after the census date of each semester.

There will be two scholarships available each year.

Eligibility

Scholarship recipients must:

- be enrolled in or enrolling in an honours degree at Flinders University specialising in performing arts; and
- be making satisfactory academic progress; and
- normally be enrolled full-time.

Applications will be accepted from part-time students who have extenuating circumstances that prevent them from studying full-time (e.g. disabilities, carer responsibilities). Part-time recipients will be paid pro-rata.

Selection

The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of:

- academic merit; and
- a demonstrated ability and passion for performing arts; and
- demonstrated interest in pursuing a performing arts career; or a doctoral program in the performing arts.

Conditions

Scholarship benefits are subject to the recipient maintaining a full-time study load, or a part-time study load where extenuating circumstances prevent full-time enrolment.

Benefits will be withdrawn if the recipient fails to maintain satisfactory academic progress, or withdraws, or is precluded from their program.

Leave will be permitted after completion of at least one semester of this scholarship, for a maximum of one semester only.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Student System by the specified closing date.

Advertising

The scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
