

Purpose

Stella and Peter Braund have established an endowed fund to support continuing undergraduate students enrolled at Flinders University to support a student under financial hardship with preference given to Indigenous / Torres Strait Islander students then to a student identifying as female studying STEM.

Source of funds

The scholarship has been established through a donation from Stella and Peter Braund.

Benefits

The Scholarship will have a value of \$5,000 per annum (subject to available funds) paid in instalments of \$2,500 after the census date of each semester. The Scholarship will be prorated for part-time students

Eligibility

Applicants for the Scholarship must:

- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident of Australia or permanent humanitarian visa holder; and
- be enrolled in an undergraduate course at Flinders University studying in internal (on-campus) mode; and
- have successfully completed at least 36 units of this course at Flinders University; and
- be able to demonstrate financial need; and
- have a minimum GPA of 4.5

Tenure

The Scholarship is awarded to a continuing student for up to 3 years of full-time study or equivalent part-time study in the course for which the scholarship is awarded. Scholarship payments are subject to meeting the University's Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy and will be withdrawn if the scholarship holder withdraws or is precluded from the course.

Leave

Leave is permitted for one semester after the first semester of payment only.

Selection

The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need and academic merit. All students meeting the above eligibility criteria are encouraged to apply, however applications may be preferenced as follows:

1. Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students
2. Female students studying STEM courses
3. All other eligible applicants.

Selection of the candidate(s) will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Student Administration.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Flinders University Student System by the specified closing date.
