

**Purpose**

The bursary has been established to encourage financially disadvantaged students who have participated in the Flinders University Foundation Course to undertake higher education.

**Source of funds**

The bursary is funded by a donation from Dr Vic Beasley. The award will continue as long as donations and earnings thereon are sufficient.

**Benefits**

Subject to the availability of funds, the bursary will be awarded annually and will be valued at \$500.

**Eligibility**

Applicants for the bursary must:

- have completed the Flinders University Foundation Course in the year before a bursary is awarded; and
- have applied for and been admitted to an undergraduate course of study at Flinders University; and
- belong to one of the equity groups targeted by the University; and
- be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia.

**Tenure**

The bursary will be awarded to a student in the first year of their course of study. Payment will be made during the first semester.

**Selection**

This bursary will be awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need and academic potential. The academic potential of applicants will be assessed by way of their performance in the Foundation Course. Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Academic and Student Services.

**Applications**

Applications should be submitted online through the Flinders University Student System by the specified closing date. Applicants will need to login and navigate to the My Scholarships tab to submit an application. The application form for this scholarship is called "Vic Beasley Bursary", or you can search for it by the keyword "beasley".
