Students undertake topics such as Introduction to Law and Justice, Essential Legal Skills, Ethics and Professionalism, Indigenous Peoples, Colonialism and Law, International Law and Global Perspectives. Graduating with this one-year Diploma of Laws meets the first-year credit requirements of both the Bachelor of Laws and Bachelor of Laws and Legal Practice at Flinders University.
