Master of Teaching (Birth to 5)

SATAC code (CS): 2CM320
Duration: 2 years
Delivery: In person / online (plus placement/intensive)

This course brings together theory and practice, preparing you for a career in early childhood settings – such as long-day childcare centres, kindergartens and preschools. You’ll gain the skills and knowledge to effectively plan, implement and advocate for transformative teaching and learning for children aged birth-to-five years.

Master of Teaching (Primary)

SATAC code (CS): 2CM116
Duration: 2 years
Delivery: In person
Graduates who wish to teach at the primary school level can undertake a Master of Teaching (Primary). Both the 1.5 year accelerated course and the 2-year equivalent provide you with the background necessary to apply for registration as a teacher and includes a rigorous course of education and professional studies integrated with professional practice.

Master of Teaching (Early Childhood)

SATAC code (CS): 2CM088
Duration: 2 years
Delivery: In person
This degree provides you with the knowledge to start a career in early childhood education. You will enter the teaching profession with confidence and competence, equipped with the skills required to work with young children aged birth-to-8 years.

Master of Teaching (Secondary)

SATAC code (CS): 2CM090
Duration: 2 years
Delivery: In person / online (plus placement/intensive)
The Master of Teaching (Secondary) is offered to graduates who wish to teach years 7-12 in secondary schools. The course provides you with the background necessary to apply for registration as a secondary teacher. Topics covered during the both 1.5 years accelerated degree and the 2-year equivalent include specialist curriculum studies, professional experience and a number of topics devoted to issues in education.

How to apply

Postgraduate coursework degrees

Applications for postgraduate coursework degrees are lodged through the South Australian Tertiary Admissions Centre (SATAC): satac.edu.au

1. Select your preferred course

2. Check entry requirements

Most graduate entry bachelor degrees, graduate certificates and graduate diplomas require a three-year undergraduate degree from an Australian university or equivalent.

There are also minimum entry requirements for each course. But if you don't meet the requirements you may be admitted (subject to specific conditions) at the discretion of the College offering the course.

Overseas qualifications need to be equivalent to the above to be considered for entry.

3. Check individual course entries on SATAC for information on important dates

Use SATAC's course search to check individual course entries for information on important dates. You will find information on commencement date options, relevant closing date(s) for applications, and the timing of offers.

Higher Degree by Research (HDR)

Applications for Higher Degree by Research (HDR) are lodged directly through Flinders University:

Ensure an academic staff member has agreed to supervise your HDR Project

3. Prepare your documentation

HDR applicants are required to provide a research outline, research experience statement and academic transcripts prior to submitting your application. Ensure you have reviewed the course rule and course information page for any additional requirements.
